

## Wisconsin Lane Closure System Advance Notification

Users are expected to enter closures according to the Advanced Warning Notification Guidelines as shown in the table below. This table shows for each closure type, the minimum number of days before the Start Date that a closure should be entered by.

### CLOSURE TYPE AND REQUIRED MINIMUM ADVANCE NOTIFICATION

<b>Closure type with height, weight, or width restrictions (available width, all lanes in one direction &lt; 16 feet)</b>	<b>MINIMUM NOTIFICATION</b>
Lane and shoulder closures	7 calendar days
Full roadway closures	7 calendar days
Ramp closures	7 calendar days
Detours	7 calendar days
<b>Closure type without height, weight, or width restrictions (available width, all lanes in one direction <math>\geq</math> 16 feet)</b>	<b>MINIMUM NOTIFICATION</b>
Shoulder Closures	3 calendar days
Lane closures	3 business days
Ramp closures	3 business days
Modifying all closure types	3 business days

Discuss LCS completion dates at weekly project meetings to manage closures nearing their completion date prior to the completion date. Enter changes in the schedule or completion date into LCS after the weekly project update meetings.
