Several highways impacted by flooding remain closed

Motorists are advised to continue checking 511wi.gov for information regarding statewide impacts.

Motorists are also reminded **not to drive through standing water or around barriers**. Use the designated detour route as many state, county and local roads are experiencing flooding.

Columbia County

- I-39 southbound reduced to one lane near WIS 33 by Portage.
- I-39 southbound ramp closed to WIS 33 (Exit 87) near Portage. No detour.
- I-39 southbound ramps to and from Cascade Mountain Road (Exit 85) closed near I-90/94 interchange. No detour.

Crawford County

- WIS 35 reduced to one lane from Prairie du Chien to Lynxville.
- WIS 171 reduced to one lane between WIS 131 (Gays Mills) and US 61 (Rolling Ground); traffic detoured via WIS 131 and US 61.
 - Motorists can expect to encounter temporary stop signs. The highway is restricted to 15-ton weight limit.

Dane County

- US 14 closed between Cross Plains and Black Earth; traffic detoured via WIS 78 and US 12.

Vernon County

- US 14 reduced to one lane at Cornell Lane, east of Coon Valley.
- WIS 131 closed between Ontario and Rockton. Traffic detoured via WIS 82 and WIS 33.
